



Golden Years Health Care Program

Senior pets need extra care and attention. Many signs of older pet diseases are hard to define. You may see gradual weight loss, increased thirst or urination, exercise intolerance, behavioral changes, joint stiffness, etc. Most of these diseases are not curable, but they can often be managed by making appropriate dietary changes, eliminating aggravating elements from their environment, and sometimes disease-specific medications are indicated. Because signs of these diseases are subtle, we recommend more frequent exams and routine geriatric testing for pets 7 years and older.

We have three comprehensive programs for senior pets, Bronze, Silver, and Gold. For the Gold Program, we recommend repeating the included services twice annually. The Gold program would require you to leave your pet, fasted, at the veterinary clinic for the day. It is up to you to choose the right program for you and your pet. We recognize that not everyone is able to do everything for their pet. You can choose just a few services of these programs if you are unable to afford the entire program.

This year we have added an additional program- the Pre Anesthetic Program for Dental Cleanings. Many geriatric (and many younger pets) have some level of dental disease. To clean your pets teeth requires anesthesia. By doing a pre-anesthetic exam and bloodwork we can make this procedure safer for your pet. The bloodwork would give us a good indication of liver and kidney function, make sure your pet isn't diabetic or hypoglycemic, anemic or dehydrated.

We will be offering discounted dental cleanings during the month of February and it would be ideal to do pre anesthetic bloodwork no longer than 1 month prior to the dental procedure. Please call and schedule early as space fills up quickly! Our hope, by making these services available, is to help improve the quality and potentially increase the duration of life for your pet. We let you decide how involved this care may be.
